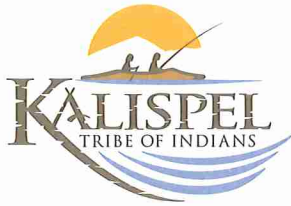

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Kalispel Business Committee is the duly Constituted governing body of the Kalispel Tribe by the authority of the Constitution and By-Laws for the Kalispel Tribe; and

WHEREAS, under the Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, the Kalispel Business Committee is charged with the duty of protecting the health, security and general welfare of the Kalispel Tribe and all reservation residents; and


WHEREAS, the Council has previously approved a revision to the Kalispel Law & Order Code Chapter 2, Criminal Procedures that includes a section on extradition that is in need of minor revision. This revision will divide the single section of 2-2.04 into multiple sections to organize matters logically and made the code user-friendly.

WHEREAS, the location of the Tribe's economic enterprise in Spokane County creates logistical issues for police officers when they detain individuals there on Spokane County warrants as tribal arrestees are housed outside Spokane County.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Kalispel Business Committee adopts the draft revisions to the extradition section of KLOC Chapter 2, including the allowance for a field waiver of extradition for individuals detained at Tribal property located in Spokane County on a Spokane County warrant.
